

## Corrected errata for ECMA-393

7 September 2010

Clarification regarding extension header handling for IPV6 proxies, clause 6.4.2 “Behavioural Requirements”, line R29.

Existing text states: “The proxy SHALL respond to ND Neighbor Solicitation messages that include extended headers”.

Proposed text is: “The proxy SHALL respond to ND Neighbor Solicitation messages that include **recognized** extended headers”.

Rationale – existing text implies a proxy must respond even if the request contained extended headers unknown to or unrecognized by the proxy.
