## 15.4.4.10 Array.prototype.sort (comparefn)

If *comparefn* is supplied and is not a consistent comparison function for the elements of this array (see below), then the behavior is implementation-defined. Let *len* be ToUint32(this.length). If there exist integers *i* and *j* and an object *P* such that all of the conditions below are satisfied, then the behavior is also implementation-defined:

- 0 *i < len*
- 0 *j < len*
- this does not have a property with name ToString(i)
- P is obtained by following one or more [[prototype]] links starting at this
- P has a property with name ToString(j).
