Dear GA members,

This is an extended click-through form and an example for 3rd party text- or software-contributions for the TC39 RF TG work.

The original click-through form for text-only contributions have been approved by the GA in June 2013. Since then there has been significant progress by the IPR group and by the CC to extend this form also for software-contributions. Such extension is needed to allow e.g. for 3rd party test modules for ES6 implementations. We carry out this vote as a letter ballot because of the urgent need for this by TC39.

Please note that this ballot has been agreed by the CC and the Ecma Management but not yet by the last GA (which is normally the case for letter ballots). The reason for this is that the IPR group has completed its work rather quickly at the end of February 2014. This work is urgent, that is the reason for launching this ballot, and not to wait until the June GA. However, if you do not agree with such a procedure please let us know and we will stop this vote and wait until the June GA.

# Non-Ecma-member contributions ("text" and "software") to the TC39 RF TG Work

As decided by the April 2013 CC meeting originally this is an additional TC39 RF TG "Operational document" added to the informational package sent to the GA (GA/2013/023: Experimental TC39 RF TG Policy package). As the whole package this was also approved by the June 2013 GA meeting.

The experimental TC39 RF policy is additional to the normal Ecma Patent Policy and it is only valid for TC39. Experimental means that based on experience further changes are possible. The idea is to create within TC39 a Royalty Free Task Group which is permitted to produce RF standards. The scope of the group has been approved by the GA. Ecma members who want to join the TC39 RF TG must fill in an appropriate registration form. While the overwhelming majority of work is expected to be done within the RF TG, the policy also should allow the exceptional possibility of non TC39 RF TG (other Ecma members and non members) sourced contributions.

Originally the form was developed to cover "text only" contributions. This version includes also "software contributions" which are expected to come up especially for submitting test software cases for ECMAScript ES 6.

The IPR group is therefore developing a modified (additions are highlighted with yellow) click-though web form (to be put on the TC39 web pages):
